Agreement for Parish Service and Support 2022-2023

Recognizing all that the Lord has done for us, we commit ourselves to help further the mission and ministry of the Church.

We realize as parents, we are the primary teachers of our children, particularly in the ways of faith. We promise to teach our children to practice this faith by attending Mass each Sunday and Holy Day as mandated by the laws of God and his Church, by seeing to it they receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Communion regularly, and by preparing them for the faithful reception of these Sacraments.

We accept responsibility to maintain our registration in our parish and to contribute to the offertory collection of the parish each week by using our envelopes and so establishing a record of our attendance. All offertory envelopes must be offered at Sunday Mass. We accept responsibility of involving ourselves in the mission, ministries, and activities of the parish to the best of our abilities.

We promise to pay the tuition on time and to notify the pastor in writing should this become difficult.

If we have been registered, contributing and attending weekly Mass in our parish for at least six months prior to enrolling our students in the school, we understand that the parishes, on their part, pledge to reduce our children's tuition to the "parishioners in good standing" (Rate A) tuition rate, depending on all of the above conditions being fulfilled. This agreement is subject to review quarterly by the pastor. Those families who do not keep to the agreement will be expected to pay the non-practicing (Rate B) rate.
