Round 5: January

(The letter in parentheses indicates whether the root word is Greek (G) or Latin (L).)

Prefix / Suffix	Meaning	Examples
Homo- (G)	Same, alike	Homophone, homogenous, homonym, homozygous
Hetero- (G)	Different, dissimilar	Heterogenous, heterozygous, heterosexual, heterotroph
- philia (G)	Love	Hemophilia, necrophilia, spasmophilia
- phobia (G)	Fear of, intense dislike	Claustrophobia, xenophobia, arachnophobia, acrophobia
Zoo- (G)	animal	Zoology, zoogeography, zooplankton, zooblast
