Prefix / Suffix	Meaning	Examples
chron (G)	time	Chronicles, chronological, chronically, synchronize
circum- (L)	around, about	Circumference, circumcise, circumnavigate, circumspect, circumvent
co- (L)	together	Codependent, copilot, coworker, coauthor, codeveloper
mort- (L)	death	Mortality, immortal, mortal, mortician
Non-	not	Nontoxic, nonpayment, nonprofessional, nonadherence
post	after	Postpone, postgraduate, postpone, posterity, postmodern
